Description

Early C19th Regency period framed carved statuary marble study of a lion's mask . Well-carved high relief study of a lion's mask in a contemporaneous 'bevelled' oak frame surround, the top fitted with a large brass hanging-ring . The square marble panel carved to the centre with the lion's mask surrounded with a circular border . Superb carved detail to the features of the lion's mask . The verso undisturbed , with a smooth plaster finish encasing the marble panel . Possibly conceived originally as an element for a chimney-piece , though seemingly having been framed in period.
