This stunning tureen is oval in shape and features an exquisite foliate border with a domed lid surmounted by a decorative acanthus leaf handle. It stands on four wonderful elegant acanthus leaf shaped feet. It is of the highest quality and is in excellent condition, this wonderful tureen with domed cover is ready to grace your dining table. The date is uncertain because no patent was taken out. The next known manufacturer was Joseph Hancock, in 1755, but others also began and in 1784 the Sheffield Plate makers obtained an Act of the Parliament legalizing a mar...
