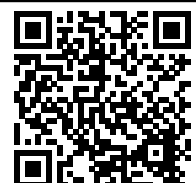
This exquisite early Victorian silver tape measure dates circa 1840. The engraved casing is very pretty and the winding mechanism fully functioning. The green silk tape unwinds to a length of 20 inches by being held by the side of the tape measure and pulling gently on the tape extremity. It can be wound back by turning the top cover clockwise. Hallmarks: Unmarked as is practically always the case with early sewing implements, but tested as silver. Dimensions: Height: 3cm / 1.2 inches. Diameter: 1.5cm / 0.4 inches. Condition: Very good.
