A well-presented 19th century antique beech and elm smoker's bow chair or captain's armchair. The smoker's bow chair has shaped, out-swept arms raised on turned spindle supports. The solid elm seat has good grain pattern and is raised on four turned legs with a double H stretcher support. Item Ref; M-2761 . DIMENSIONS: Height – 80cm / Width – 64.5cm / Depth – 60cm / Seat Height – 46cm . CONDITION REPORT: In good antique condition throughout with some signs of age. There is surface wear in places including age-related marks and staining to the seat (pictured). There is a small split to the front of the seat. The smoker's bow chair remains structurally solid and sturdy with good tight joints. There is evidence of old historic wood worm to the legs and some losses to the feet. Overall, a rather neat example with particularly nice grain pattern to the seat.
