UK POSTAGE ONLY FOR THIS ITEM Gents 9ct gold Cyma wrist watch for J W Benson. The watch has a Swiss 15-jewel (three adjustments) hand-winding movement which is working nicely. The movement has been identified as a Cyma piece. The watch measures 22mm wide excluding the winding crown and 33mm high excluding the lugs. The case is 9 carat gold and there are hallmarks inside the hinged case back for Birmingham 1935 with a case maker's mark for Aaron Dennison. The Dennison Watch Case Company was based in Birmingham and they supplied many watch makers with cases. The case is in good condition, just some unevenness to the case back but not too serious. The convex lens has a couple of light scratches but you have to look quite closely to see them. The dial is signed with the name of the original retailer of the watch, J W Benson of London. J W Benson originated in 1847, founded by James William Benson and Samuel Suckley Benson. They were regarded as one of Victorian London's most prestigious retail jewellers and they also manufactured their own watch movements. The company flourished and proudly boasted an elite client base made up of both British and European royal...
