Technical Description A very rare 18th-century Syllabib glass dating to around 1740. It has a lipped deep conical bowl with two applied handles above a conical folded foot. Snaped pontil. **Comments** Syllabub was a very popular dessert drink from the 18th century, made from wine, claret, or sherry with a topping of frothy cream, lemon, or other species....there were a number of recipes. This particular glass is very special, with very few having twin handles. We have never seen one with such a pronounced conical bowl!. **Date & Origin** England, c1740. Period of George II. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration **Dimensions** Height: 12.1cm Rim diameter: 4.6cm Foot diameter: 6.8cm.
