A late Victorian silver quaich or two handled bowl with good clear hallmarks for Chester 1899 and makers mark for George Nathan and Ridley Hayes. A quaich is Scottish bowl with two handles (known as lugs), symbolising friendship. This quaich has a simple plain design and finish. It stands on a cast raised silver base. The simplicity of design reflects the essence of friendship. The hallmarks are clear, the condition is excellent. Weight 150gr.

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
