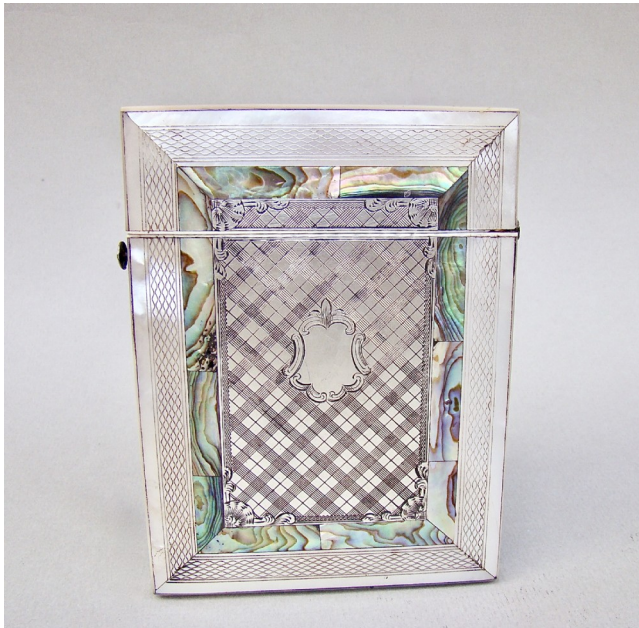

This beautiful Victorian inlaid silver, abalone and mother of pearl visiting card case was made circa 1870. Of rectangular form, the front inlaid with a large silver panel engraved with an engine-turned tartan pattern decorations surrounding a vacant cartouche. Both front and back with an inner abalone border and engraved mother of pearl frame. The push button on the front opening to reveal the original velvet lined interior. Quite charmingly, a Victorian visiting trade card is still in the case! Thus adding to the history of the piece. Hallmarks: Unmarked but tested as silver.
