Description

A fine example of a type of cupboard peculiar to West Wales where they were often used for storing blankets and bedding. Made at the beginning of the 19th century, the cupboard has many attractive features: the rich colour and deep patina, the mahogany and chequer strung frieze with well proportioned ogee arches to the door panels, flanked on either side by quadrant pilasters, as well as panelled sides. The five drawers set in an unusual arrangement provide lots of storage. The striking handles, whilst not original, are of the period. Typically, the secondary timber is pine. Cardiganshire circa 1800-20
