Fine and rare Scottish George II oak longcase clock with 8 day striking movement by Robert Miller of Alloa. The lovely case with pagoda top to hood and great boxwood fretted panels and with carved wood gilded corinthian capitals to columns. The arced truck door with feather inlay. A most unusual feature to movement is strike/silent and repeat small levers to dial just under the arch at each side. All in full working order. The case is in excellent condition with little repair except the old replacement feet. Wonderful soft honey colour with very fine waxed patina. A most handsome clock and a rare early example from Scotland. Comes with all keys. Size; 92" high, 20" wide at hood, 11" deep at hood. Approx. delivery cost in mainland U.K. £80
