A very good late 19th century French CARRIAGE CLOCK in perfect working order ~ indeed the "action" of the original lever platform is particularly energetic and robust! Unsigned (though possibly by Henri Jacot ~ there are similar features with many of his clocks and it comes with a numbered Jacot winding key) this good example is within its 'Corniche' case with bevelled glass panels all around. The eight-day movement strikes hours and half-hours on a gong, and it has an additional and fully working alarm train. The enamel dial is perfect as are the original blued steel hands.
