A fine etching by Giacomo Barri (1636-1690) after a work by Paolo Veronese (1528-1588). It depicts the adoration of the shepherds at the birth of Christ. The etching was created in 1667 and this 19th-century version is most probably a restrike using the original plate. Giacomo Barri was a leading Italian printmaker from the Baroque period. He hailed from Venice and is best known for his book, *Viaggio pittoresco d'Italia*, which provides descriptions of old master paintings across various Italian cities.
