The natural camel-hair field consists of a myriad of tiny 'botehs' - flame symbols of Zoroastrian origin and the proto-type of the Kashmiri shawl and Paisley patterns. Made by Baluch tribes in the south-east region of Persia circa 1880, the hand panels contain nicely-drawn 'trees-of-life' and the rug is in very good overall condition with some minor repairs only. Size: 1.12m x 0.87m (3' 8" x 2' 10").
