The etui is composed of three pieces: the top lid, body and base cap which may all be disassembled. The exterior and interior of the case are wonderfully gilt in a rich gold colour with further embellishments of engine turning/guilloché that reflects light magnificently. This etui is rather large compared to the usual small sewing needle cases and allows for an array of items to be stored within. Today it may be used for ornamental purposes or any creative ideas such as storage of pills, mints, or small sewing tools. A Minerva french silver hallmark is present on the side of the top lid.
