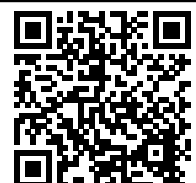
Description

Of imposing scale, this Welsh oak chest on chest has a number of features which make this such a splendid example of its type. In two sections, the upper one with a well defined cornice and geometrically inlaid frieze with double ogee carved stops at the top and base of the inlaid canted angles. The sides have a single large recessed panel. The lower section has a brushing slide and shaped bracket feet with pronounced cusps flanking a central shaped and pierced fretted device resembling a smiling mouth. The sides have a single flush panel. The graduated drawers retain an almost complete set of original brass handles. The beautifully figured native oak has a rich colour and excellent patina. Carmarthenshire, reputedly from Llanwrda/Llangadog, circa 1795-1810.
