A wonderful and rare silver White Port wine label from the late 18th Century. This excellent example is of rectangular form with clipped corners and a reeded border. 'White Port' is pierced to the centre in 'pricked' capitals. The label is supported on a belcher chain. White port is rather rare, compared to the more commonly found Port label and hallmarked in 1792, this is an interesting and collectable piece. Dimensions below.
