A lovely Georgian silver decanter label, with 'Orange' engraved across the front in 'pricked' letters. The reeded border has squared corners and the reverse is hallmarked. Supported on a belcher chain, this is a rare collector's item. Orange was widely believed to be for an Orange based liqueur such as Grand Marnier. In fact it refers to Rhone wines from the Orange region in France. Dimensions below.
