A brass and silvered dial with corner spandrels and a well engraved dial centre. A seconds and date dial. Lunar moon phases to the arch with country painted scenes. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Circa 1785. James Booth of Manchester is recorded in Loomes' 'Lancashire Clocks and Clockmakers' book as working in 1782. The Booth family of clockmakers are noted as making quality clocks. Height 7ft 8" / 234 cms Width (at widest point of hood) 23" / 60 cms Depth 11" / 29 cms.
