Royal Worcester porcelain double walled, 'reticulated' jug, dated 1889. The body of the jug, worked in the manner of George Owen, with the body pierced in a honeycomb design, divided by shield like motif, and enamelled. Having two finely gilded panels of painted country scenes. The waisted neck, with stylised flowerheads, in raised enamels and gilt. Having a bamboo style handle, heightened in gilt. Green printed factory marks and date code for 1889 to the base. Height – 10.4 cm, 4 1/4". Width – 9.5 cm, 3 3/4". Condition – Perfect. No damage. No restoration.
