An extremely rare silver label, dating from the early Victorian era. This beautiful example is fully cast and hallmarked. It has 'Beer' pierced in the centre and is supported on a belcher chain. Silver decanter labels were usually for wine, spirits or table sauces (often called bottle tickets). The very rare 'Beer' examples were most often found in the better taverns or ale houses, around the necks of flagons or carafe's. A collectable and sought after example. Dimensions below.
