On the reverse 'Adelphi Theatre 1906' is at the top and on the body, 'With Otho Stuart's compliments' is written. Otho Stuart was a famous actor/stage director, debuting in 1886 and dying in 1930. These wonderful pieces were sold over a number of years as fundraisers for Scott's Expeditions. An exceptionally rare vesta, with interesting Theatre and historical connections. Dimensions below.
