Description

A late 19thC oak framed bronze plaque of a hunting dog or hound dating to c1880. Almost certainly originating in France, the scene depicts a pointer or similar hunting dog, on point, amid an expansive landscape and woodland. As is typical of French bronze casting, the bronze image is finely detailed and the pointer's coat is lightly gilded for heightened effect. The plaque bears no visible signature. The light oak frame bears a label for E Rousseau, of Dunkerque in Northern France, advertising mirrors, gilding and framing. Almost certainly the plaque is in its original frame.
