The long oak lined end drawer has original lions mask brass pulls echoed at the other end with a similar faux drawer. A good colour and grain with some minor blemishes which serve to prove is 200 + years age. 84.5 cm wide 50 cm deep when closed and 106 cm when flaps are raised. 71cm high.
