The makers initials are also present JMB for the silversmith John Millward Banks, who had retail premises in the heart of London's West End. The front has a beautiful shamrock or four leaf clover (good luck) decorated in vibrant green guilloche enamel which remains undamaged. The letter opener acts as a handle to utilize the magnifying glass which has an excellent magnification, beautifully clear and very usable over 110 years later.
