Built in 1886 by Walter Ralph Bankes (1853-1904) as a hunting lodge, this attractive Victorian country house was designed by a Scottish architect and has been described by an architectural historian as a "Queen of Bands" house as the tower and ornamentation is said to be inspired by Victorian band stands. The tale is that he used it in his bachelor days for entertaining and that he never returned after his marriage. The house has always been a private house and has been leased by the Anderson family since 1926 when Gen. Stuart Anderson...
