Has lovely pierced splats, curved arms supported by well turned uprights and raised in finely turned legs united with a shaped crinoline stretcher. Unusually even the back legs are yew. All in superb un-touched original condition with just a crack to the base of the left hand arm upright. Wonderful honey colour with magnificent waxed patina.
