A stylish arts and crafts period wardrobe by Shapland and Petter of Barnstaple. Of fine construction in solid walnut and with many design features redolent of the period. With a row of inset blue/green enamel plaques to the top. With a mirrored door to the left which opens to reveal full height hanging space. The cupboard door to the right is fitted with a splendid embossed copper plaque and opens to reveal a shelved interior. With 2 short drawers beneath and one long deep drawer to the base. All fitted with original brass and copper hardware. The two cupboard doors are lockable (key supplied) and the locks are stamped S P B. Sympathetically refinished in our workshops and now offered for sale in excellent condition ready to go straight into the home. Splits into two sections for ease of installation. A rare opportunity to acquire a fine item of arts and crafts furniture. Dimensions: Width 117cms Depth 51cms Height 201cms The Shapland and Petter factory was established by cabinetmaker Henry Shapland (1823 – 1909), following a trip to America in 1848. While there, he saw an ingenious new machine which he realised could be used for cabinetmaking. Upon his return to Barns...
