Description

Antique silver pocket watch from J W Benson. The watch has a Swiss 15-jewel stem-winding movement, identified as by Revue, which is working nicely. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside both of the case backs for Birmingham 1919 with a maker's mark for the Birmingham based case maker Aaron Dennison. The case is in good condition, just a slight indentation to the back and general light surface marking. The glass lens is in lovely condition. The dial is signed with the name of the original retailer, J W Benson, London. The dial is in lovely condition. J W Benson originated in 1847, founded by James William Benson and Samuel Suckley Benson. They were regarded as one of Victorian London's most prestigious retail jewellers and they also manufactured their own watch movements. The company flourished and proudly boasted an elite client base made up of both British and European royalty and a selection of well heeled industrialists and business figures including the King of Siam, the King of Portugal, the King of Denmark, the Emperor...
