The lid has a facet cut finial above a field of graduated diamond cuts. The graduated diamonds continue down the curved bowl and again into the stand rim which is finished with a large star cut. The workmanship is truly outstanding. **Date & Origin** England, c1860. Period of Victoria **Condition** There is a single-chip to stand rim as shown. The lid, bowl, and remainder of the stand we would describe as near pristine with light wear to the base stand as expected.
