Star cut base. Although this design was copied by a number of manufacturers such as Edinburgh Crystal in the late 19th and early 20th century this is almost certainly a Rishardsons Stourbridge example and a very fine piece. Historical Relevance W. D. Boyce incorporates the Boy Scouts of America on February 8, 1910.
