The guard cast with the regimental or royal cypher of intertwined "VR" for Victoria Regina (Queen Victoria) . The blade bearing a patent design registration number . Designed and manufactured by Benham & Froud of Chandos St., London (1855-1924) . The truncated blades of the sabres mounted with an adjustable light-fitting and topped with parchment shades .
