Circa 1900-1930 a large spelter figure of a racing pigeon perched on a layer of rocks with the signature of Louis-Albert Carvin (1875-1951) clearly visible on the side. Carvin was a well known for his animal sculptures in bronze and spelter. The figure measures approximately 25.5cm in height, 24cm across and 20cm in depth, and it is in good condition with no signs of damage or repair. The black marble base is original and it has green and white streaks throughout, matching the slightly green colouring of the pigeon.
