Adjustable vernier marker and makers name and address (the maker at the address on the instrument between 1850 - 55). Matching scale to the mercury action thermometer in glazed removeable box to the centre of the instrument. Polished brass remote adjuster for the vernier marker and plate to the front reading 'This barometer reads correctly to Greenwich standard'. Fully restored movement and presented in immaculate condition with a deep shine and original patina. Measures 44" long x 5.5" wide at widest point x 3" maximum depth.
