We are delighted to offer this beautiful Victorian solid silver bowl made by Charles Stuart Harris in London, 1895. The bowl is of a good size, practical for modern-day usage such as a fruit/punch bowl or for storing a bottle of wine/champagne with some ice. Additionally, the bowl would grace a fine dining table as part of stylish interior decor. The exterior of the bowl features some fluting on the bottom half and fine Victorian floral garlands chased above. The bowl is raised by a pedestal foot which is crafted sturdily and the interior is fully gilt with a rich gold tone, contrasting the exterior silver colour and adding a layer of protection to prevent the contents from tarnishing the silver. English hallmarks are present on the side of the bowl - marks are worn but can be identified.
