Beautifully executed and full of atmosphere. In very good condition with the canvas very clean and having no paint loss or damage. The frame measures 80cm X 65cm. The canvas measures 60cm X 45cm. Herbert William Weekes was a well-known English genre and animal painter of the Victorian Neoclassical period who specialised in portraying animals in humorous, human-like situations. It seems that he preferred to use his middle name and his works are mostly signed "William Weekes" or just WW. Born: 8 May 1841, Pimlico, London. Died: 21 November 1914, Primrose Hill, London. His work was exhibited in many English establishments including The London National Gallery and Grosvenor Gallery.
