Cherub Mk.II log dial mounted upon a fixed bracket. Ceramic dial set behind an opening glass porthole door - some age related loss present. Annotated with a main log of 0-100 miles, with an auxiliary dial for 1-10 miles. Replete with the distinctive trailing fin and hook. Extensively engraved to rear of log with the Thos. Walker maker's mark. Thomas Walker of Birmingham further noted upon the dial. T.W. Anchor trade mark engraved to each trailing fin.
