Description

George II period, mahogany pad foot gateleg dining table, Circa 1750. This fairly small oval top dining table is construction from good early solid mahogany. Top with rounded edge, with drop leaves which are supported by gatelegs from either side. Turned tapering legs with off-set pad feet. A charming early period table, with marks and blemishes, and a few repairs, but full of character. In a reasonable condition, cleaned and waxed, and ready for use. Dimensions: This table measures approximately 71 cm (28") tall, 115 cm (45") leaves up, 39 cm (15.5") wide leaves down, and 107 cm (42") deep. Condition: Please see the pictures for details of the items condition. - This table is in fairly reasonable condition, commensurate with its age, and is structurally sound and sturdy enough to use. Numerous old marks and blemishes. Some repairs, including the top of one leg on the shoulder joint, several plugs and fills in the top, chips above the hinges on one side, and chips to the toes of one foot. Generally pleasing patina. Ready for use. - As with all vintage & antique furniture there will be signs of use, marks, wear & tear, etc.

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
