Description

George II/III period, solid oak wall hanging corner cabinet, Circa 1760. This corner cabinet constructed in solid English oak, features a panelled door, brass hinges and escutcheon, lock and working key, moulded cornice top with moulded plinth base. The interior has been painted brown, and has three shelves with scalloped front edges. A charming and quality cabinet in a good condition. Cleaned and waxed. Very serviceable and ready to use. Dimensions: This cabinet measures approximately 95 cm (37.5") tall, 75 cm (29.5") wide, and 44 cm (17.5") deep. The back corner to either side corner measures 51.5 cm (20"). Condition: Please see the pictures for details of the items condition. - This cabinet is in a good condition, commensurate with its age, and is structurally very sound and sturdy. Some odd marks and blemishes, in keeping with a piece of this age. Replacement but period hinges and escutcheon. Some old paint splatter on the hidden top. Very serviceable and ready to use. - As with all vintage & antique furniture there will be signs of use, marks, wear & tear, etc.

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
