Dimensions: Width 110cms Depth 55cms Height 99cms Holland and Sons Antique Furniture (1803 – 1942) were extremely good cabinet makers and they specialised in fine quality furniture. Holland and Sons were founded in 1803 by William Holland and by the middle of 19th century, they were one of the main competitors to the furniture makers Gillow. Originally, They were cabinet makers and upholsterers called 'Taprelland Holland'. In 1843 they changed their name to 'Holland and Sons' with William Holland in control, a relative of the well known Regency architect Henry Holland. Holland and Sons soon started to expand quickly and by 1851, they employed over 350 cabinet makers. By 1852 they took on the prestigious firm of Thomas Dowbiggin of 23 Mount Street, London, who had previously made the throne for Victoria's Coronation. Holland a...
