GIII mahogany Pembroke table. Of exceptional colour and patina, this rare drop-leaf table is closely similar to a design published in Thomas Chippendale's "The Gentleman and Cabinet Maker's Director" of 1754, plate number 33. The rectangular top with shaped leaves on chamfered legs connected by a pierced cross-stretcher and fitted with a drawer and a corresponding dummy; with original axe-drop handles. Circa 1760 Where the stretchers cross in the middle, a shaped metal plate has been applied underneath; it has been there a long time. 36 ¾" (93.5cm) max wide [width with flaps down 21 ½" 54.5cm], 32 ¾" (83cm) max deep and 28" (71cm) high John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940.
