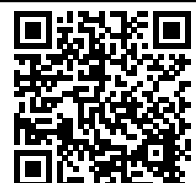
Description

A well carved mahogany case with the original top wooden finials. Signed to the enamel barometer scale 'Maple & Co, London as retailers'. The main circular dial is marked 'Improved Torricelli Barometer'. Circa 1895. I have never seen such a high quality example of a Royal Polytechnic barometer. They are usually oak cased and paper/silver dials, this is mahogany and enamel dials. Height 42 " / 107 cms Width 9 1/2 " / 24 cms Depth 3 " / 7 cms.
