A quality Georgian bracket clock by Ellicott of London. Choice flame mahogany veneers of good colour to the well proportioned case. A stepped chamfered top with cast pineapple finial and 4 side finials. Side sound brass fretwork with silk backing and side handles. Inset brass decorations to the case front. A twin fusee, mechanism striking the hours on a bell. An engraved back plate border and pendulum. Pull repeat cord. Brass bun feet. A convex painted dial with blued steel hands signed 'Ellicott Royal Exchange London' with a cast brass bezel surround and convex glass. A strike/silent lever above X11 position. Circa 1825 The Ellicott family are noted clockmakers and are recorded in Baillies' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of the World' book as working in the 18th and 19th centuries. Edward was clockmaker to the King and various examples can be seen in museum's.
