Late Georgian period, set of 8 mahogany framed upholstered dining chairs and carvers in Hepplewhite taste, dating from the early C19th (George III period). This quality set of dining chairs feature a shield shaped with carved pierced splat, with ornate carved wheatsheaf motif. The carvers with open shaped, carved arms. Overstuffed seats covered in champagne coloured silk blend woven fabric, with striped and flowers enclosed in diamonds. Scoped front seat rail and rounded side seat rails. All raised on fluted tapering square legs with spade feet, square swept rear legs and supported by H-stretchers. A high quality, handsome, period set of chairs in good and original condition, and ready for use. Constructed in good early high quality mahogany, these chairs are very heavy. Dimensions: These chairs measure approximately 95.5 cm (38") tall, 53 cm (21") wide, and 57.5 cm (23") deep. The seat height is approximately 47 cm (19"). The carvers measure approximately 98 cm (39") tall, 62.5 cm (25") wide, and 61 cm (21") deep. The seat height is approximately 47 cm (19").
