Having a fine feathered grain, that gives it a very striking appearance. The Georgian oak chest is of a great compact size, fitted the usual 2 short and 3 long drawer combination, all graduated in depth as they go down to the bracket feet. This is a rare piece made of a small size and the unique timber, its colour is like you find on golden honey walnut. Imagine how good this is going to look in your home, and it can be used in downstairs setting or in a bedroom or landing.
