A fine quality 8-day duration twin fusee mechanism with rarer quarter striking on 2 bells. Border engraving to the mechanism and pendulum with higher quality pendulum regulation scale. Hour bell striking. The original pendulum transportation lock and winding key. The original key to the front and rear opening doors. Circa 1815.
