Description

Antique Single Fusee English Four Glass Library Clock With Campaign Carry Handle. This beautiful antique library clock has a lovely case with a fantastic rich colour. The top of the case is flat with a stunning inlet campaign carry handle which is extremely rare to see. The top of the case then has a lovely shaped moulding leading to the square body of the case. The body then has glass panels to the front and back as well as stunning, thick bevelled glass panels to the sides to that the movement can be fully seen. Below the body is then a lovely "bell" shaped section which is often seen on library clocks. Finally there is another thin moulding leading to the base which is finished by four thin, round brass feet. Both doors then have their locks and keys. The dial is then silvered and set out in black Roman numerals with a thin ring to the outside marking the minutes. The centre of the dial then has a beautiful engine turned pattern to the centre. The dial is then finished by two lovely shaped hands. Finally the movement is wound from the front and adjusted from the back and is ticking away as it should. The movement is a single fusee example of the upmost quality an...
