A very large pair of continental factory porcelain figurines, both in 17th century dress, with the lady holding a basket of flowers and the gentleman in full dress with hand on sword as he stands at ease. Underneath they are marked with "cross swords" and there are the capital letters S and a G, stamped over each other. The condition report is that the gent has a hat missing which was held in his left hand. Also the half of his thumb is absent from the hand holding the sword. A very small corner piece of the waistcoat is missing. The condition of the lady is fine with no visible damage. Neither figurine has had any previous repairs and would be fairly easy to complete the required restoration to the gentleman figurine. MEASUREMENTS: Height: 19 Inches High Width: 7 Inches Base Diameter. These are large figures, unusual to find today, and in perfect condition would have been considerably higher in price.
