Description

With an overall design of diamond-shape lozenges which appear to disappear under the selvedges and out into infinity, the weaver has captured a small part of Paradise by incorporating it into a bag for containing rock-salt. Woven by Sanjabi Kurds at the end of the 19th century, the face of the bag is intricately woven in countered soumak technique with the back woven in plain-weave using undyed sheep's wool. Size: 59cm x 30cm (1' 11" x 1' 0").
