Description

I love the simplicity of the ivory cotton plain-weave and the insertion of tufts of wool on the front face and a single tuft on the back. The base of this salt-bag is in knotted-pile to give resilience to the bag during use and a feature generally found on salt-bags and saddle-bags of the Bakhtiari tribes. This unusual namakdan was probably made at the end of the 19th century, is in excellent condition and retains its braided hanging cord. Size: 55cm x 46cm (1' 10" x 1' 6").
