A VERY RARE 15 DRAWER COLLECTORS CABINET BY THOMAS GURNEY, CABINET MAKER, BROADWAY, LONDON FIELDS. ONE OF THE MOST FAMOUS AND ACCOMPLISHED CABINET MAKERS OF THE 19th AND EARLY 20th CENTURY WHOSE WORK IS VERY MUCH SOUGHT AFTER BY COLLECTORS. THIS EXAMPLE IS PURE 'ART NOUVEAU' IN STYLE WITH CLASSIC FITTINGS AND HINGES AND BURR OAK PANELS TO THE DOOR. OAK HAD BECOME THE FASHION IN THE EDWARDIAN ERA AND THIS TYPIFIES THE PERIOD PRECISELY. SUPPLIED TO THE NATIONAL GALLERY OF WALES BY MESSRS WATKINS & DONCASTER PROBABLY IN THE 1950'S. THE FIFTEEN DRAWERS ARE FASHIONED IN OAK AND MAHOGANY AND RUN SMOOTHLY ON HIDDEN BEARER RUNNERS. EACH HAS THE ORIGINAL CLOSELY FITTING GLAZED FRAME TOP AND ARE PAPERED AND BASE LINED WITH PLASTAZOTE. ALL ORIGINAL GLASS. GURNEY USED THE CLASSIC BRASS DROP HANDLES OR ALTERNATIVELY TURNED EBONY. THE DOOR CARRIES HIS IVORINE PLAQUE STATING NAME AND ADDRESS OF THIS HISTORIC COMPANY OF CABINET MAKERS.
